

Membership fee regulations of MaxTex association (from contribution year 2026)

- Members acc. **§ 3 number 1 a and b** of association articles
 - annual turnover up to €15 million € 1,200 p.a.
 - annual turnover of more than €15 million € 3,600 p.a.
 - annual turnover of more than € 100 million € 6,000 p.a.

- Members acc. **§ 3 No. 1 c** of association articles € 1,000 p.a.*

*or benefits in kind, support and personnel benefits of at least the same monetary value, the specific nature and scope of which must be determined at the beginning of membership.

- Members acc. **§ 3 number 1 d** of association articles
 - are free of charge for the first 3 years of membership. Afterwards, the above fee scale of the members according to § 3 number 2 a - c of association articles will be effective
- Members acc. **§ 3 No. 1 e** of association articles € 5,000 p.a.
- Members acc. **§ 3 No. 1 f** of association articles € 1,200 p.a.
(after three years of membership, an adjustment in line with the standard scale is provided for)

The fee refers to the financial year (calendar year), § 1 number 3 of association articles. The decisive basis for determining the amount of the contribution is the respective total, i.e. possibly worldwide, company turnover.

If you join during the current calendar year, the membership fee will be calculated on a pro rata basis per quarter. This is based on the start of the quarter in which membership begins.
